SPONSORING ENTITY FORM UPDATE**

TITLE 16, CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS, SECTION 1495.1

SECTION 100. CHANGE WITHOUT REGULATORY EFFECT

The Board of Registered Nursing is amending Section 1495.1 of Article 10, Division 14 of Title 16 of the California Code of Regulations (CCR) to reflect non-substantive changes to the form entitled, "Registration of Sponsoring Entity Under Business & Professions Code Section 901," Form 901-A (DCA/2014 - revised), which was incorporated by reference in the section mentioned above. These proposed changes do not materially alter any requirement, right, responsibility, condition, prescription, or other regulatory element of any CCR provision.

The Board of Registered Nursing is proposing the following non-substantive changes to 16 CCR Section 1495.1:

- Section 1495.1(a): "... 'Registration of Sponsoring Entity under Business & Professions Code Section 901,' Form 901-A (DCA/20142016 - revised), which is hereby incorporated by reference."
- Section 1495.1(b): "... 'Registration of Sponsoring Entity under Business & Professions Code Section 901,' Form 901-A (DCA/20142016 - revised) on behalf of the board."
- Section 1495.1(b): "... receipt of Form 901-A (DCA/20142016 - revised) in writing that the form is ..."

The Board of Registered Nursing also is proposing the following non-substantive changes to the form:

- The contact information on page 4 of the current form shows contact information that has recently changed. The processing of the form has been transitioned to a new office.
