The National Council of State Boards of Nursing (NCSBN) has created a [National Nursing Education Database](#). It is the first ever nursing education database providing sophisticated statistical analyses of U.S. nursing education programs.

Database Features:

- Provides an in-depth look at how different characteristics impact the performance of U.S. nursing education programs.
- Includes information about the program makeup, students, faculty and program directors.
- Shows how key quality indicators impact programs and how programs compare with each other.
- Allows filtering by degree, geography, ownership and enrollment to better understand the impacts of each.
